About Eva Kor:

Recipient of the 2017 Sachem award, the highest honor in the state of Indiana, Eva Mozes Kor is a survivor of the Holocaust, a forgiveness advocate, and a revered public speaker. With the driving message of “never give up” in mind, Eva has emerged through a life filled with trauma as a brilliant example of the power of the human spirit to overcome. She is a community leader, a champion of human rights, and tireless educator of young people. Even in her eighties, Eva has been traveling across the United States and Europe to share her message, in addition to leading hundreds of people on a journey to Auschwitz each year. Eva is one of the few surviving twins still sharing her personal account of the medical experiments supervised by Nazi doctor Josef Mengele at Auschwitz.

In addition to the importance of her account of the Holocaust from a historical perspective, Eva’s life lessons and message of survival and forgiveness touch the lives of thousands of people. In 1995, Eva chose to forgive the Nazis. She decided that they would no longer have power over her life. She describes forgiving the Nazis as an act of self-healing, self-liberation, and self-empowerment; forgiveness is not about the perpetrator, not about forgetting. It is one step toward repairing the world by helping victims free themselves from perpetrators and remove anger and hatred.

Eva is one of thirteen survivors featured in *New Dimensions in Testimony*, a new interactive technology created by USC Shoah Foundation to preserve survivor testimonies and continue the dialogue between Holocaust survivors and learners far into the future. Her story is documented in the award-winning film *Forgiving Dr. Mengele* and the popular young adult book *Surviving the Angel of Death: The True Story of a Mengele Twin in Auschwitz*. Her story of forgiveness is also recounted in the German book *Die Macht Des Vergebens (The Power of Forgiveness)*. Premiering in April 2018, Eva’s story will be the subject of a feature-length documentary, *Eva A-7063*.

In 1995, Eva opened CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center in Terre Haute, IN. The only Holocaust museum in Indiana, CANDLES is also the only organization in the world dedicated to the memory of the twin victims and survivors of medical experimentation at Auschwitz. Thousands of people, including many school groups, have visited CANDLES since it opened. Eva’s account of her survival of the Holocaust offers many relevant lessons on the dangers of hate speech and prejudice, and the importance of being an informed citizen. Eva’s message of healing reaches across the globe and across social, economic, and cultural boundaries.

- Complete pages 8-11 of the registration packet and submit to CANDLES.
- Submit the \$750 nonrefundable deposit with your registration. **Your registration will not be processed and your spot will not be reserved until your deposit has been received.**
- Submit a copy of your passport to CANDLES by August 3, 2018 ("complete" trip package only).
- **If you do not have a passport**, apply for it immediately. Those applying for a passport on or after June 1, 2018 should expedite your passport application and shipping in order to receive your documents by August 3, 2018.
- Pay your balance in full by June 16, 2018.
- Get ready for an amazing experience!



Guidelines for Participation

General Guidelines:

- Only one participant per registration form is allowed.
- Each participant will read and submit, either electronically or in writing, an agreement that releases CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center from liability to his/her person and belongings while on the trip.
- All participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Travelers under age 10 are not permitted on this trip.
- All participants understand that CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center offers this trip as educational programming and is not a travel agency.

Participants:

- CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center reserves the right to refuse participation in its domestic and international trips to anyone who might present a physical, mental, or emotional threat to other participants/staff.
- All participants may be asked to undergo a limited criminal history background check from their state of residence and Indiana at their own expense.
- Trip participants are not allowed to use their access to other group members as a way to sell or solicit goods, products, or services to or from other group members.

Registration:

- To confirm your registration and secure your spot on the trip, a **nonrefundable deposit of \$750** per person is required with your registration. **Your spot will not be guaranteed until your deposit has been received by CANDLES. Please send deposit in with mailed registration or within 10 days of electronic registration.**
- Payment options:

 2. Call CANDLES at 812.234.7881 and pay by credit card over the phone (***Note: a 3% transaction fee will be added to all credit/debit card payments**)
 3. Complete the Credit Card Authorization Form (see page 13 of the registration packet) and mail to CANDLES (***Note: a 3% transaction fee will be added to all credit/debit card payments**)
- Your full trip balance is to be **paid in full by June 16, 2018.**
- After March 31, 2018, any change from the “complete” trip package to the “land” trip package will result in a \$100 fee, and your flight reservation will be forfeited.

Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellations received prior to close of business on June 16, 2018 will result in a cancellation fee of 50% of monies paid (not including the nonrefundable \$750 deposit).
- For cancellations received between June 15, 2018 and close of business on August 4, 2018: the “land” trip package is nonrefundable and nontransferable; for those booking the “complete” trip package, the economy class airfare of \$1000 (less a \$100 airline fee) can be refunded.
- Beginning August 5, 2018, all monies paid are nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- All merchandise sales are nonrefundable.

Passports:

- A passport valid through March 14, 2019 is required for international travel.
- Those booking the “complete” travel package are required to provide CANDLES with a copy of the passport you are traveling with no later than **August 3, 2018.**
- **Travelers who do not submit a passport copy by this date will be charged a fee of \$100, moved from the “complete” trip package to the “land” trip package, and will be responsible for booking his/her own international flights.**



Guidelines for Participation (cont.)

Trip Services:

- For updates to the itinerary or requests for information, CANDLES staff will use the contact information you provide. Registrants are asked to respond in a timely manner to all communications from CANDLES staff.
- Flight and hotel rewards for participants booking the “complete” trip package are not promised and may not be available.
- Trip packages are purchased as offered.

Accommodations:

- A single/private room is available on a limited basis at an additional cost of \$575.
- Rooms can accommodate a maximum of two (2) people.

Travel Arrangements:

- Tour bus transportation from Terre Haute, IN to O'Hare International Airport in Chicago, IL is available to trip participants at no additional cost.
- Participants flying with CANDLES from O'Hare that are not riding the bus from Terre Haute will meet at the airline check-in counter.
- Participants not flying with CANDLES will submit their travel arrangements in advance for scheduling purposes.
- Participants not arriving and/or departing Cluj/Budapest with CANDLES are responsible for their own transportation to and from the airport. If you need assistance with these arrangements, please contact CANDLES for suggestions.

Trip Insurance:

- Actual trip insurance rates vary depending on state of residence and purchase of a single room supplement. Participants will be charged according to the insurance rate schedules provided on the CANDLES website.
- Trip insurance is highly recommended. For questions about trip insurance, please contact CANDLES for insurance resources and information.

Media and Photos:

- All participants are asked to read and sign the CANDLES Publicity Release.
- Participants agree to the use of their image and likeness in trip media and photos while on the trip.
- Any use of participant images/likeness by third party individuals/organizations that are not affiliated with or approved by CANDLES will require additional permissions from the trip participants.

Please Note:

- Air travel to Cluj, Romania is very limited regarding travel dates, times, and air lines. **Please be sure that if you choose the “land” trip package, you have your flight arrangements secured with deposits.**
- Arrival into Cluj, Romania by train is not recommended.



Tour Pacing Guide

Please read carefully before registering for the CANDLES Romanian Heritage trip.

The CANDLES staff welcomes people of all abilities and will do everything within our power to accommodate any need. However, due to differences in accessibility and standards outside of the United States, there are limitations as to what we are able to provide and accommodate. We are happy to provide more detail to help you determine your ability to participate in each part of the trip.

Leisurely				On-the-Go

Please read the following carefully so you are fully informed about the physical expectations of this trip:

Walking/Terrain:

- This tour is considered an “on-the-go” pace, which means there will be a considerable amount of walking every day of the trip. Please consider this when choosing shoes.
- The city walking terrain consists of cobblestones or marble surfaces that can be uneven at times and slick when wet.

Whole-Day Tours:

- A typical day begins with a 6:00/6:30am wake up call and an evening return time of 7:00/7:30pm (not including evening meals that take place after the evening return time).

Accessibility:

- Unlike the United States, Romania and Hungary do not require their public locations to be ADA compliant. There are most likely curbs, areas with restricted or no automobile access, and stairs as the only access to upper-floor locations and lower floor/basement bathrooms. There is an elevator in the hotel.
- The bathtub/shower combination in European bathrooms is very tall, and in most cases, there are not “grab bars” for stability when entering/exiting. **There are a very limited number of handicapped rooms or shower-only rooms available, so if you require one of these rooms, please request immediately. Availability is not guaranteed.*

Tours:

- Both the Cluj and Budapest cities are largely walking tours with some steps.
- Elevators are available in the Great Synagogue in Budapest.

We do not wish to discourage participation in any way, so please feel free to contact us with questions you may have about tour pace, accessibility, or accommodations.



Responsibility Statement

Participant's Responsibility:

- By acknowledging the following, you agree to timely compliance with the payment schedule as outlined in the tour conditions and guidelines set forth.
- You understand that the tour pricing is based on the number of participants stated in the tour conditions, and that the prices may change up or down with decreases or increases in the number of participants.
- Other criteria could impact the tour cost and thus increase or decrease your cost.
- You agree that in the event that the proposed services cannot be provided due to cancellation or unavailability of said services, CANDLES Inc. reserves the right to make substitutions of features of equal value and similar quality, per the Agent Responsibility paragraph below.
- You also agree that you have a read and understand the physical demands and limitations of accessibility as outlined in the registration materials.
- You understand that offered trip insurance is optional, and that without the purchase of this insurance, CANDLES has no responsibility to, nor does it provide, insurance coverage for medical or other reasons.

- By acceptance of trip membership, Participant agrees to the foregoing and also agrees that CANDLES, Inc. maintains no control over the independent suppliers that will be providing accommodations and services as part of the trip.
- Accordingly, the undersigned agrees not to hold CANDLES, Inc. responsible for any loss, damage, injury, or inconvenience which may be caused or contributed to by such suppliers or by any other cause, condition, or event whatsoever beyond the direct control of CANDLES, Inc., nor shall Agent be held liable or responsible for any such occurrence which may take place during Participant's off-itinerary activities.
- The undersigned hereby releases CANDLES, Inc. and its respective officers, directors, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all liability for claims resulting from any acts or omissions of the independent travel suppliers providing accommodations and services in connection with the trip, or from any other cause, condition, or event beyond the direct control of CANDLES, Inc.

Trip Insurance Terms

Optional Trip Insurance:

- Trip insurance is highly recommended for your own protection and will not be provided unless you select the option for your age group.
- Trip insurance does not cover situations of political unrest or your cancellation due to unease with travel warnings.
- A portion of your deposit will be used to purchase your insurance premium.
- If you choose to decline optional insurance coverage and experience any medical situation or situation that would have otherwise been covered by the insurance, these expenses will be your responsibility to pay out-of-pocket and are not eligible for reimbursement.
- If you add additional items to your trip package that increase your total cost to more than \$4,500 (i.e. Danube view room, single room supplement), then your overall trip value may move up to the next cost tier.
- Rate schedules and description of coverages for those living in New York, Kansas, Montana, Washington State, or Maryland can be found on the CANDLES website (in the trips section).
- Group travel insurance is not available to those living in Pennsylvania, but you may purchase insurance outside the group. Please call the agent as indicated in the document on the CANDLES website for those rates and to purchase.

“Complete” Trip Package Insurance:
