

Twins Yitzhak Lazarovits and Gitel Yoskovitz (Tziporah Lazarovits)

were born on July 1, 1929 in Tarna-Mare, Romania. They were two of eight children of Sereleh and Yehuda Lazarovits.

Both were forced on death marches in January 1945: Yitzhak survived three labor camps before liberation at Melk (Austria) by US forces; Gitel survived three labor camps before liberation at Rochlitz (Germany) by US forces.
