75th Anniversary of Auschwitz Liberation January 25 - February 2

Walk in the steps of Eva Kor, Holocaust survivor and forgiveness advocate

January 27th, 2020 marks the 75th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz. Join CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center for an extraordinary experience as we travel to Auschwitz for the commemoration of the anniversary. In 2015, nearly 300 survivors from Poland and across the world attended the commemoration event. More than 50 leaders of countries and international organizations listened to the words of the witnesses. The Auschwitz Museum hopes to see many survivors and prisoners return for the 75th anniversary. Eva Kor is one of the growing number of survivors no longer with us, but we honor her life by attending the commemoration.

In addition to participating in ceremonies by the Auschwitz Museum, trip participants will learn about the history of the camps from museum guides. We will also walk in the footsteps of Eva, hearing the account of her arrival at Auschwitz, separation from her family, experimentation by Nazi doctor Josef Mengele, the struggle for survival, and her and her twin sister Miriam's liberation by the Soviet Army on January 27, 1945.

About Eva Kor:

Eva Mozes Kor passed away at age 85 on July 4th, 2019. Recipient of the 2017 Sachem award, the highest honor in the state of Indiana, Eva was a survivor of the Holocaust, a forgiveness advocate, and a revered public speaker. With the driving message of "never give up" in mind, Eva emerged through a life filled with trauma as a brilliant example of the power of the human spirit to overcome. She was a community leader, a champion of human rights, and tireless educator of young people. Even in her eighties, Eva traveled across the United States and Europe to share her message, in addition to leading hundreds of people on a journey to Auschwitz each year. Eva was one of the few surviving twins who shared her personal account of the medical experiments supervised by Nazi doctor Josef Mengele at Auschwitz.

In addition to the importance of her account of the Holocaust from a historical perspective, Eva's life lessons and message of survival and forgiveness touched the lives of thousands of people. In 1995, Eva chose to forgive the Nazis. She decided that they would no longer have power over her life. She described forgiving the Nazis as an act of self-healing, self-liberation, and self-empowerment; forgiveness is not about the perpetrator, not about forgetting. It is one step toward repairing the world by helping victims free themselves from perpetrators and remove anger and hatred.

Eva is one of thirteen survivors featured in Dimensions in TestimonyTM, a new interactive technology created by USC Shoah Foundation to preserve survivor testimonies and continue the dialogue between Holocaust survivors and learners far into the future. Her story is documented in the award-winning film *Forgiving Dr. Mengele* and the popular young adult book *Surviving the Angel of Death: The True Story of a Mengele Twin in Auschwitz*. Her story of forgiveness is also recounted in the German book *Die Macht Des Vergebens* (*The Power of Forgiveness*). In April 2018, Eva's story premiered as the subject of a feature-length documentary, *Eva A-7063*.

In 1995, Eva opened CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center in Terre Haute, IN. The only Holocaust museum in Indiana, CANDLES is also the only organization in the world dedicated to the memory of the twin victims and survivors of medical experimentation at Auschwitz. Thousands of people, including many school groups, have visited CANDLES since it opened. Eva's account of her survival of the Holocaust offers many relevant lessons on the dangers of hate speech and prejudice, and the importance of being an informed citizen. Eva's message of healing reaches across the globe and across social, economic, and cultural boundaries.

- Submit the \$600 nonrefundable deposit (+ insurance premium if purchased) with your registration. Your registration will not be processed and your spot will not be reserved until your deposit has been received.
- Submit a copy of your passport to CANDLES by November 8, 2019 ("complete" trip package only).
- **If you do not have a passport**, apply for it immediately. Those applying for a passport on or after August 8, 2019 should expedite your application and shipping in order to receive your documents by November 8, 2019.
- Pay your balance in full by November 8, 2019.
- Get ready for an amazing experience!



Guidelines for Participation

General Guidelines:

- Only one participant per registration form is allowed.
- Each participant will read and submit, either electronically or in writing, an agreement that releases CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center from liability to his/her person and belongings while on the trip.
- All participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Due to the graphic nature of some content on this trip, caution is recommended for participation of children age 14 and under. Travelers under age 10 are not permitted on this trip.
- All participants understand that CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center offers this trip as educational programming and is not a travel agency.

Participants:

- CANDLES Holocaust Museum and Education Center reserves the right to refuse participation in its domestic and international trips to anyone who might present a physical, mental, or emotional threat to other participants/staff.
- All participants may be asked to undergo a limited criminal history background check from their state of residence and Indiana at their own expense.
- Trip participants are not allowed to use their access to other group members as a way to sell or solicit goods, products, or services to or from other group members.
- All participants are asked to complete and submit a confidential medical form. A physician's release for travel may be required depending on the participant's medical conditions.

Registration:

- To confirm your registration and secure your spot on this trip, a **non-refundable deposit of \$600** per person plus your insurance premium in full (if purchased) is required with your registration. **Your spot will not be guaranteed until your deposit has been received by CANDLES**.
- Payment options:

 - 2. Call CANDLES at 812.234.7881 and pay by credit card over the phone (*Note: a 3% transaction fee will be added to all credit/debit card payments)
 - 3. Complete the Credit Card Authorization Form (see page 14 of the registration packet) and mail to CANDLES (*Note: a 3% transaction fee will be added to all credit/debit card payments)
- **CANDLES does not accept checks drawn on foreign banks.** Those living outside the U.S. are asked to pay via credit card or wire transfer. If paying by wire transfer, there will be a \$20 acceptance fee in addition to any fees charged by the bank initiating the transfer.
- Your full trip balance is to be paid in full by November 8, 2019.
- After November 8, 2019, any change from the "complete" trip package to the "land" trip package will result in a \$100 fee, and your flight reservation will be forfeited.
- If you are registering online but mailing payment, payment should reach CANDLES within 10 days of registration.

Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellations received prior to close of business on November 8, 2019 will result in a cancellation fee of 50% of monies paid (not including the nonrefundable \$600 deposit).
- For cancellations received between November 9, 2019 and close of business on December 9, 2019: the "land" trip package is nonrefundable and nontransferable; for those booking the "complete" trip package, the economy class airfare of \$950 (less a \$100 airline fee) can be refunded.
- Beginning December 10, 2019, all monies paid are nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- All merchandise sales are nonrefundable.

Drug Policy:

• The use of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited at any time. International laws and penalties with regard to the possession and use of narcotics are more severe than in the United States. Whether a juvenile or adult, you are subject to Polish law and policies while in the country.



Guidelines for Participation (cont.)

Passports:

- A passport valid through August 3, 2020 is required for international travel.
- Those booking the "complete" travel package are required to provide CANDLES with a copy of the passport you are traveling with no later than **November 8, 2019**.
- Travelers who do not submit a passport copy by this date will be charged a fee of \$100, moved from the
 "complete" trip package to the "land" trip package, and will be responsible for booking his/her own
 international flights.

Trip Services:

- For updates to the itinerary or requests for information, CANDLES staff will use the contact information you provide. Registrants are asked to respond in a timely manner to all communications from CANDLES staff.
- Flight and hotel rewards for participants booking the "complete" trip package are not guaranteed.
- Trip packages are purchased as offered.
- Because hired services for the trip are contracted based on the number of total participants, registrants will not be permitted to switch from one trip to another in the event that a second trip becomes available.

Accommodations:

- A single/private room is available on a limited basis at an additional cost of \$400.
- Most rooms can accommodate a maximum of two (2) people. Some rooms may be available that accommodate three (3) occupants, but this must be requested in advance and availability is not guaranteed.

Travel Arrangements:

- Tour bus transportation from Terre Haute, IN to O'Hare International Airport in Chicago, IL is available to trip participants at no additional cost.
- Participants flying with CANDLES from O'Hare that are not riding the bus from Terre Haute will meet at the airline check-in counter.
- Participants not flying with CANDLES will submit their travel arrrangements in advance for scheduling purposes.
- Participants not arriving and/or departing Krakow with CANDLES are responsible for their own transporation to
 and from the airport/train station. If you need assistance with these arrangements, please contact CANDLES for
 suggestions.
- One checked bag and one carry-on are included with the economy class group airfare.

Media and Photos:

- All participants are asked to read and sign the CANDLES Publicity Release.
- Participants agree to the use of their image and likeness in trip media and photos while on the trip.
- Any use of participant images/likeness by third party individuals/organizations that are not affiliated with or approved by CANDLES will require additional permissions from the trip participants.

Trip Insurance:

- Actual trip insurance rates vary depending on state of residence and purchase of a single room supplement. Participants will be charged according to the insurance rate schedules provided on the CANDLES website.
- Trip insurance is highly recommended. For questions about trip insurance, please contact CANDLES for insurance resources and information.

Law Enforcement While Abroad:

• CANDLES trip participants arrested by foreign authorities, juvenile or adult, are not the responsibility of CANDLES. If arrested, the participant may be subjected to prosecution by local law enforcement authorities and must understand that CANDLES has no obligation to defend him/her in such proceedings. Parent/guardian and chaperone will be given the phone number and address of the appropriate law enforcement agency to contact.



Tour Pacing Guide

Please read carefully before registering for the CANDLES Auschwitz trip.

The CANDLES staff welcomes people of all abilities and will do everything within our power to accommodate any need. However, due to differences in accessibility and standards outside of the United States, there are limitation as to what we are able to provide and accommodate. We are happy to provide more detail to help you determine your ability to participate in each part of the trip.

Leisurely		On-the-Go

Please read the following carefully so you are fully informed about the physical expectations of this trip:

Walking/Terrain:

- This tour is considered an "on-the-go" pace, which means there will be a considerable amount of walking every day of the trip. **We average 18,000-20,000 steps (6-8 miles) per day**. Please consider this when choosing shoes.
- The city walking terrain consists of cobblestones/marble surfaces that can be uneven at times and slick when wet.
- The walking terrain in Auschwitz is mainly gravel/dirt or larger stones and can be rough and uneven at times.

Whole-Day Tours:

- A typical day begins with a 6:00/6:30am wake up call and an evening return time of 6:00/6:30pm (not including evening meals and presentations that take place after the evening return time).
- The schedule for the entire trip is rigorous, with little rest/recovery time between days. Please consider this when
 registering for the trip.

Accessibility:

- Unlike the United States, Poland does not require their public locations to be ADA compliant. There are most likely curbs, areas with restricted or no automobile access, and stairs as the only access to upper-floor locations and lower floor/basement bathrooms. There is an elevator in the hotel.
- Participants must be able to board and exit the tour bus independently.
- Most buildings in Auschwitz I require travelers to navigate large steps and are not wheelchair accessible.

Tours:

- Both the Krakow city tour and Jewish Quarter tour are two-hour walking tours on uneven cobblestone streets.
- The historic salt mine tour is also two hours in length. Access to the mine is via one of their historic mine elevators. Most walking surfaces in the mine are smooth, and the regular tour has steps that descend to each level of the mine. *A handicap version of the salt mine tour is available and must be reserved ASAP. Availability is not guaranteed. Those who would like this tour must have proof of need.
- We will spend two full days touring the Auschwitz camps. There are only sporadic locations where one can sit to
 rest (other than on the ground), and there are no regularly spaced benches or paved walking surfaces.
- Auschwitz-Birkenau is a large area with few trees for shade. Be prepared to walk in full sun, rain, or snow, depending on the season in which you are visiting.
- There are no water fountains at Auschwitz I or Auschwitz-Birkenau. Water must be carried.

While we do not wish to discourage participation in any way, we want you to have a realistic expectation of the physical demands of this trip. Please feel free to contact us with questions you may have about tour pace, accessibility, or accommodations.



ADA Accomodations for Trip

Transportation:

For guests traveling with us who are in need of ADA accommodations and are unable to independently board a motor coach due to a dependency on a wheelchair or walker, transportation with the group, via motor coach, is not guaranteed. In a situation where the group motor coach is not accessible due to participant's dependability on a wheelchair/walker for mobility, alternative transportation options can be discussed with CANDLES staff.

Hotels:

European hotel accommodations which are ADA compliant are extremely limited and are not guaranteed. We will make every possible effort to make reservations at properties that are ADA compliant, but our doing so is entirely dependent on hotel availability.

The bathtub/shower combination in European bathrooms is very tall, and in most cases, there are not "grab bars" for stability when entering/exiting. *There are a very limited number of handicapped rooms or shower-only rooms available, so if you require one of these rooms, please request immediately. Availability is not guaranteed.

Mobility/General Assistance:

While CANDLES staff will certainly help as time and situation allow, registrants who require an enhanced level of assistance with mobility and/or everyday tasks are required to travel with a companion/caregiver. Staff will not be available nor provided for this level of daily assistance.

Locational Accessibility:

Please note that many European sites are not ADA compliant, including many buildings and structures on our tours, including the Auschwitz Memorial Museum. Walking paths at Auschwitz are often uneven and covered in large gravel/stones or grass and are difficult to manage if you are restricted to a wheelchair or walker.

A handicapped accessible, abbreviated tour of the Wieliczka Salt Mines is available but will only be booked as needed. If there is a request in this regard, advance notice and proof of need are required. A reservation for the abbreviated tour must be made in advance of arrival.

Those who have knee/hip/back issues may benefit from bringing a device to assist with walking and stability.



Responsibility Statement

- You understand that you are required to complete both a registration form and a confidential medical form.
