Margit and Jenő Gruner, with ten-year-old Agnes, were Jewish Hungarians living in Budapest at the time of the Nazi invasion. After the Gruners were forced into a “Jewish Designated” or “Yellow Star” building, their Catholic housekeeper took Agnes to safety. Agnes lived as her niece: a hidden child living in the open but living in fear. Raoul Wallenberg saved Jenő Gruner by hiding him in a safe house. Margit Gruner was deported and perished in the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp. Agnes’s story of survival, perseverance, and devotion to family is told in her book, *A Roll of the Dice*.
